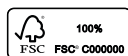

Andalusia, a tourism universe

It is one of the most comprehensive tourism destinations in the world, as well as being considered one of the safest by visitors.

Andalusia offers an entire scaled-down tourism universe, the defining feature of which, is diversity. A variety reflected to perfection in **amazing landscapes** with contrasts that will enable tourists to enjoy warm valleys such as the Guadalquivir, the highest peaks of the Iberian Peninsula, fertile hill ranges, stretches of coasts barely touched by humans and volcanic rock formations such as the Tabernas Desert, the only one of its kind in Europe. A wealth of landscape and natural resources, with **protected areas of extraordinary ecological importance** located in the region of Andalusia, such as the national parks of **Sierra Nevada and Doñana**, home of the Iberian lynx.

This valuable environmental heritage, together with the **picturesque quality of**

its villages and deep-rooted traditions, attract visitors to our region each year, looking for a **more rural form of tourism** where they can be in contact with nature, in places such as the White Villages in Cadiz, the Serranía de Ronda (Malaga), the troglodyte habitat of Guadix and Altiplano (Granada), the Alpujarras in Granada and Almeria, the mining landscape of the Sierra Morena in Jaen and the Sierra de Aracena in Huelva.

Here, visitors can enjoy activities such as trekking, climbing, paragliding, cycle-tourism, white water rafting or skiing in the Sierra Nevada Ski and Mountain Resort. Not to mention the fact that Andalusia has the largest selection of **golf courses** in the whole of Europe.

The Andalusian coastline, stretching for more than 900 km and bathed by the waters of the Atlantic and the Mediterranean, offers **beaches** for all tastes, from **vast sandy beaches and small coves** to those equipped with all the facilities and services required to enjoy a perfect day out with all the family. Many of them receive the **Blue Flag Award for Clean Beaches in Europe** each year, making them the ideal place to practice **water sports** such as surfing, windsurfing or sailing.



The historical, cultural and monumental wealth of Andalusia is in itself an invitation to come and explore and it represents the identity of a land with a **vast artistic legacy** distributed across the entire region. Archaeological sites, a fabulous Hispanic-Moorish architecture, castles and fortresses, churches and monasteries, majestic mansions and immense industrial architectural works, all together form a hugely significant heritage, which has been recognised by the UNESCO, with the following being included on the **World Heritage** list: the Alhambra, Generalife and Albaicín in Granada; the

Historic Centre of Cordoba, including the Mosque-Cathedral and the Jewish Quarter; the Cathedral, Fortress and the General Archive of the Indies in Seville; the Archaeological Ensemble Dolmens of Antequera, the Caliphate City of Madinat Al-Zahra and the Rock Art of the Mediterranean Basin on the Iberian Peninsula.

It is the birthplace of **great artists and writers** such as Velázquez, Murillo, Lorca, Alberti, Juan Ramón Jiménez and Picasso, among many others, as well as being home to some of the best **museums in Spain**, such as the **Museum**

of Fine Arts in Seville, considered to be the second art gallery in Spain, the avant-garde **Pompidou Centre** and the Picasso Museum, both in Malaga. It is also the **setting for highly renowned and prestigious cultural contests**, that include all artistic fields and also **festivals** that reflect the **open and cheerful nature** of the Andalusian people, such as Easter Week (the central theme of the Route of Passion), the Cadiz Carnival or the April Fair in Seville.

Andalusian cuisine, based on Mediterranean ingredients, has gained international acclaim thanks to the **excellence of the products** (with numerous quality hallmarks) used by **Andalusian chefs** recognised with the stars awarded by the Michelin Guide, such as Ángel León and Dani García, in the creation of innovative and cutting-edge dishes but inspired by tradition. The gastronomy is, therefore, **extensive and imaginative**, and the best way to discover it is by trying **small portions of its gastronomy via tapas**, a gastronomic trend that is popular in the entire region.

It is one of the warmest regions in the whole of Europe, with over 3,000 hours of sunshine per year and average annual temperature of 16 °C

The relationship between what is purely tourism-related and the values that appeal to the senses that take us back to our origin, are the focus of this proposal, with the main theme being the Al-Andalus, Sephardic and Ibero-American cultures.

What is 'Andalusia, your Roots'?

The tourism initiative is aimed at markets seeking Moorish, Sephardic and Ibero-American tourism.

'**A**ndalusia, your Roots' is a **strategic project** developed by the Department of Tourism of the Regional Government of Andalusia, which goes beyond purely tourism aspects, by **incorporating values and aspirations** that appeal to historical and family bonds, in short, to people's **origin**. This innovative initiative offers travellers the chance to enjoy **unique experiences** related to their ancestors, in a region like Andalusia, which has always been an example of coexistence and cultural pluralism.

This is an **opportunity for development** created with a clear focus on the **business and tourism sector**



of Andalusia, to generate local employment and wealth, but also with the aim of building bridges between different communities and cultures which, over the centuries, have left a permanent mark on our region.

In order to attract tourists with historical, ancestral and deep-rooted bonds with Andalusia, this pioneering

project plans to **develop and promote our products and tourism packages** aimed at three **strategic segments**: tourism based on Moorish heritage, Sephardic tourism and Ibero-American tourism. This is the proposal that will be included in this Catalogue 'Andalusia, your Roots'.

The professional manual will offer **over one hundred experiences** distributed

across the entire region of Andalusia, which will enable visitors to the region in search of their 'roots' to not only enjoy **tourism experiences** with heritage resources dating back to the Al-Andalus period, but also take part in **Al-Andalus cooking workshops** and visit **areas with clear Al-Andalus roots**; visit the Jewish Courters of **Sephardic Andalusia**, with **gastronomic visits to**

kosher-friendly restaurants and attend **concerts in Ladino**; or visit places related to such relevant figures such as **Inca Garcilaso de la Vega**, among other sites.

Presented in the Caliphate City of **Madinat Al-Zahra**, recently declared World Heritage Site by the UNESCO, 'Andalusia, your Roots' has already

been promoted in **fairs, trade missions and FAMtrips** and presented to **agents specialising** in Jewish and Sephardic tourism in the United States and Israel; in the Hispano-American sector, in Argentina and to the **Council of Arab Ambassadors** and Arab intermediaries. It has also been presented to the **World Tourism Organisation**, the **Necstour Network** and the **European Parliament**.

Halal/halal-friendly tourism, one of the strategic segments of 'Andalusia, your Roots', is a recent phenomenon that covers a series of activities related to the **lifestyle of Muslim travellers** and which is having a growing economic impact at a global level. This is a new model of

tourism and a great opportunity for the tourism sector in the region of Andalusia, a region with an **identity** marked by **Islamic heritage**.

Spain is one of the most highly-rated destinations by Muslim tourists, particularly because it is the European destination with the most significant **Hispano-Moorish heritage**. And a large part of that monumental legacy is located in Andalusia, with **World**

Heritage Sites related to the Arab culture, such as the **Mosque** and the Caliphate City of **Madinat Al-Zahra**, both located in Cordoba, the **Alhambra and the Generalife** in Granada or the **Giralda** in Seville. These and other artistic treasures form part of the itineraries included in the **Routes of the Al-Andalus Legacy**, which cover the eight provinces in Andalusia, recalling landscapes, traditions and flavours from times gone by.

The tourism products offered to Muslim travellers by **'Andalusia, your Roots'**, also include services exclusively aimed at **respecting the beliefs and religious practices** relating to Islam. An example of this are the **'halal' hotels**, which do not serve alcoholic beverages; they offer "halal-certified" menus; they offer prayer rooms; and, in general, a pleasant and welcoming environment. In fact, the **type of accommodation** is one of the most important parameters

for Muslim tourists when organising holidays, which are normally **group or family holidays**.

Halal cuisine, based on Islamic religious precepts, forms part of many other tourism experiences in 'Andalusia, your Roots', either as part of routes that combine elements of heritage, nature and gastronomy, by way of workshops or sampling events. An entire culinary universe that inspires **Al-Andalus cuisine**.

The golden past of Al-Andalus draws tourists from mainly Muslim countries such as Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, United Arab Emirates (UAE), Qatar, Iraq, Kuwait, Iran and Oman



Activities such as visits to bazaars and marketplaces, Arab baths with relaxing massages, traditional music festivals and pottery workshops, enable Muslim tourists to establish that **bond with their roots**, which has brought them to Andalusia. Without forgetting other **more personalised plans**, which include routes across the numerous natural spaces in Andalusia, nautical experiences, important sporting events or shopping in the exclusive international designer stores.

Sephardic roots

Sephardic Jews.

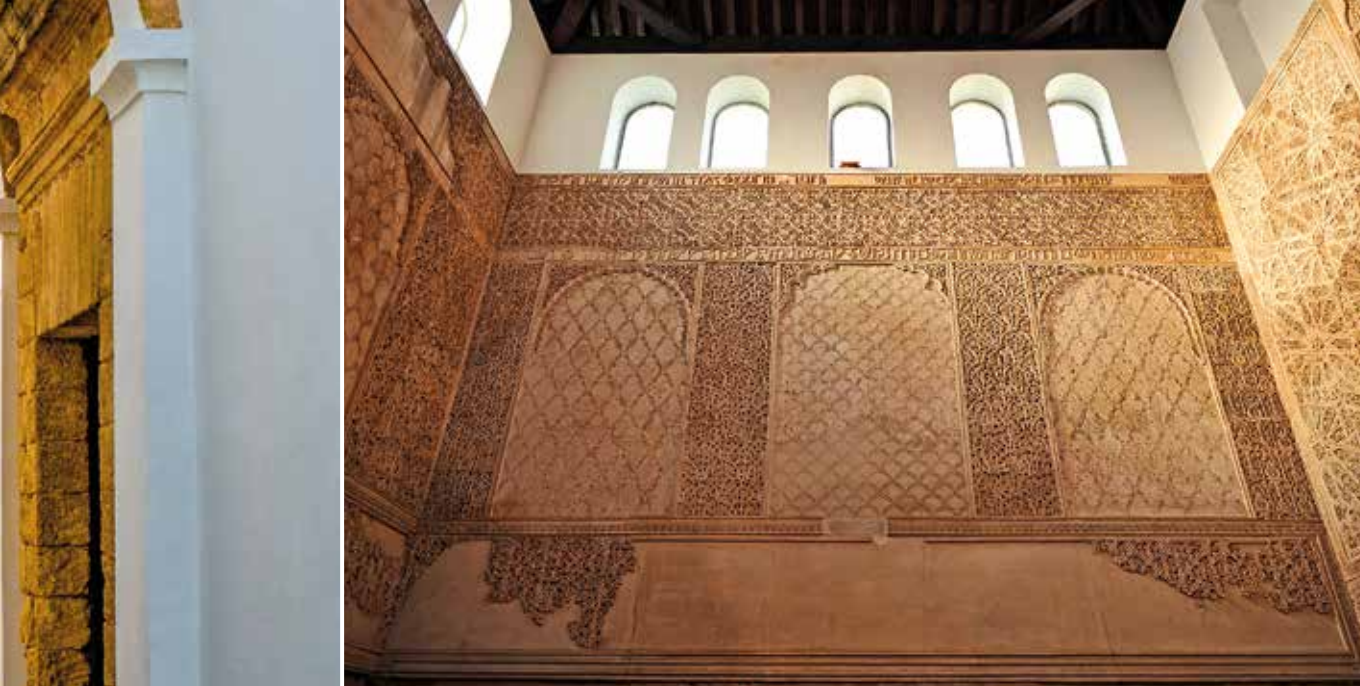
Derived from the Hebrew Sepharad, place name originally identifying the Iberian Peninsula.

Jews from countries such as the United States, Israel, Canada or Argentina feel a special attraction towards Andalusia as a tourism destination.

Andalusia was, for centuries, a region that welcomed the Jewish community



Today, the descendants of Spanish Jews, **the Sephardic Jews**, represent around one fifth of the global Jewish population. Hence the importance given to this strategic segment, **Sephardic Tourism**, in the **'Andalusia, your Roots'** project, promoting tourism products that enable the **origins** of visitors' ancestors to be discovered, who were forced to abandon the peninsula in 1492. They left, but their roots, their houses, their

The Jewish presence is amassed in the form of **monuments** that possess an exceptional artistic value, such as the **Cordoba Synagogue** (one of the four preserved in Spain dating back to the medieval era), the **Synagogue of Water** in Ubeda and the **Jewish Necropolis in Lucena**, the largest Jewish cemetery ever excavated in Europe, dating back to the Medieval period. Not forgetting the Jewish gastronomy, traditions, legends and relevant characters such as the doctor and mathematician from Cordoba **Maimonides**, probably the most important Hebrew figure to have been born on the Iberian Peninsula, with the permission of Hasday Ibn Shaprut.

districts and their places of prayer remained in Andalusia.

Their historic traces are present in the different **routes** designed for the Sephardic community: **Large Capitals, Western Andalusia and Inland Andalusia**. They are the perfect opportunity to experience the Jewish influence in this region, by visiting important sites such as the **Jewish**

quarter in **Cordoba** (which forms part of the Historic Centre of Cordoba inscribed on the **World Heritage List**), **Jaen** and **Lucena**, known as the Pearl of Sepharad.

These three towns form what is known as the triangle of Al-Andalus and they belong to the **Sepharad Routes**, a tourism initiative organised by the **Network of Jewish Quarters in Spain**.

In order to highlight the Sephardic culture and heritage, attracting visitors to return to the land of their ancestors, 'Andalusia, your Roots' also offers interesting **personalised proposals** that take into account particular features of this culture, in aspects such as gastronomy. Tourists can enjoy **concerts in Ladino** and take part in Sephardic **arts and crafts and food workshops** or K kosher oil and wine **tasting events**, among many others.

Ibero-American roots

Ibero-American.

adj. Native of Ibero-America, a group of American countries that formed part of the kingdoms of Spain and Portugal.

Many people from Andalusia emigrated during the 19th century to the New Continent, intensifying their sentimental bonds that still remain today with their descendants.

The General Archive of the Indies in Seville is home to the most important documentary source of the cultural and commercial relations between Spain and the New World



Andalusia developed **close relationships with Ibero-America** from the end of the 15th century, closely related to the **Discovery of America** and the subsequent trade activity that was established between continents. Trade activities that resulted in bonds from the **comings and goings** on both sides of the ocean related to traditions, folklore, art or gastronomy.

Huelva, Seville and Cadiz are the three provinces in Andalusia that were most prominent during this historic period which really was the **Golden Age** of

Andalusia. In 1492, **Christopher Columbus** set sail from the **Port of Palos** in Huelva to discover America. In 1503, Seville became the head of the commercial monopoly with the New World, since it was there that the Casa de la Contratación de Indias was established, an institution that moved to Cadiz in 1717.

'**Andalusia, your Roots**' proposes **five routes** that include the following scenarios: The Preliminaries of the Discovery; The Kingdom of Granada; The first journey to the Indies; The

Gateway to America; The Atlantic Ports and Explorers, viceroys and indianos. Itineraries that will enable visitors to admire the Andalusian Mudejar works of art (first art of Columbian America), Andalusian cathedrals such as those in Seville and Jaen, which had a great influence on the religious architecture of America, and beautiful Baroque alcoves, with the background echoes of flamenco music influenced by the comings and goings from and to the Americas.

Particularly interesting is the mark left by famous characters that forged

Cordoba is one of the most repeated names in countless towns and cities of America, such as Cordoba in Veracruz, Mexico or Cordoba in Tucuman, Argentina



fascinating landscapes of the Modern and Contemporary Ages of the two continents. Special mention must be given to figures of the distinguished adopted montillano, **Inca Garcilaso de la Vega**, **Francisco Solano** “the American evangeliser”, **Diego Alvear y Ponce de León**, the **Gálvez** family from Malaga, or **José San Martín**, a prime military leader in South America successfully achieving Independence and he had a prominent role in the Battle of Bailén against the Napoleonic troops.

These **cultural, linguistic, religious and family ties** form a heritage reflected in 'Andalusia, your Roots', creating a complete tourism offer, managed by experts that will help travellers explore their “roots”. It also includes monumental itineraries for travellers to discover the **very best of architecture with Hispano-American influences**, visits to wineries and to Spanish Fighting Bull farms, **gastronomic routes** in which Iberico ham is the main protagonist and taverns in Cordoba, food pairing workshops and Flamenco-based tourism experiences.

Andalusia, your Roots

The legacy of Al-Āndalus

Since its arrival in 711, Islam represents a prodigious adventure for Andalusia, emerging in a cultural and artistic legacy, the value of which is incalculable.

The remnants of Al-Andalus

This civilisation excelled in the areas of farming, culture, arts and sciences, leaving behind a legacy of outstanding artistic value recognised by the UNESCO as World Heritage.

At the beginning of the 8th century, Muslims crossed the Straits of Gibraltar, reaching the Iberian Peninsula. In just ten years they would shape the region we know as **Al-Andalus**, where they would coexist for around **eight centuries** with other cultures, including the Christian and Jewish cultures, a unique phenomenon in medieval Europe. In 1492, the Catholic Monarchs would conquer the kingdom of Granada, defeating its last king,

Boabdil, expelling the Nasrid dynasty and thus marking the end of a historical period that brought economic prosperity and artistic and cultural splendour to Andalusia.

The region of Andalusia is home to some of the **most important** monuments of western Islamic art, declared **World Heritage**. **Cordoba** is home to the **Mosque-Cathedral**, with its unique forest of dichromatic columns and its

Al-Andalus brought together philosophers, historians, doctors, poets and musicians such as Ziryab



admirable Mihrab boasting inscriptions of the Koran in gold and the sumptuous **Caliphate City of Madinat Al-Zahra**, built at the foot of the Sierra Morena by the first caliph of Al-Andalus, Abd al-Rahman III, as a symbol of his power.

In **Seville**, which became the capital of the Almohad empire after the decline of Caliphal Cordoba, the Arab vestiges can still be admired in some Al-Andalus parts of the Alcazar or **Reales**

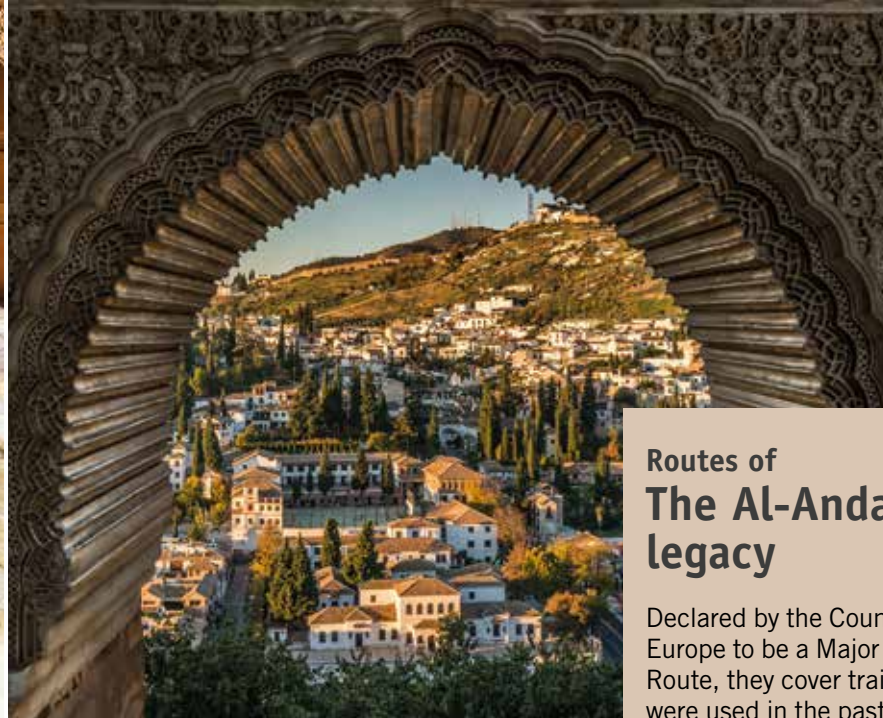
Alcázares and in the orange tree-filled patio, **Patio de los Naranjos**, the patio of ablutions and the minaret -the popular **Giralda**- from the old mosque, now a Christian **Cathedral**.

Granada, the centre of the Nasrid dynasty, where the epilogue of Al-Andalus began, was a vast metropolis during its time, in which lavish palaces were built including those housed inside the **Alhambra in Granada**,

which is home to all the arts of the last Muslim period in Spain and an unrivalled example of how **light and water** offer important architectural decorative effects. It offers visitors the chance to see quarters such as the **Patio of the Lions**, photographed thousands of times.

Arab baths and fortresses

The Muslims, characterised for having a **profoundly urban culture**, put all their

constructive know-how into the cities, which they walled and equipped with towers, gates, **alcazabas** (Moorish fortifications) and castles. Particularly noteworthy are the **alcazabas in Almeria and Malaga**, and the **alcazar fortress in Jerez de la Frontera** (Cadiz) and the walled enclosures of Granada, Cordoba and Seville, with the famous **Tower of Gold** on the banks of the Guadalquivir, the “Rio Grande” (Wadi al-Kabir) from Al-Andalus.

Routes of The Al-Andalus legacy

Declared by the Council of Europe to be a Major Cultural Route, they cover trails that were used in the past to communicate the Kingdom of Granada with the rest of Andalusia, Murcia and Portugal. The routes lead to more than 280 villages across Andalusia, offering travellers the chance to enjoy peaceful landscapes, discover their traditions, cuisine, popular festivals and customs.

Other defensive structures also appeared across the coastal and inland regions of Andalusia, such as the walled enclosures in **Marchena** (Seville), **Niebla** (Huelva) and **Palma del Río** (Cordoba); the alcazabas in **Loja and Guadix**, both in Granada, and the **castles in Baños de la Encina** (Jaen) and **Salobreña** (Granada), among others.

Inside the major cities, in the Medina, mosques, bazaars, grain markets, silk markets and **Arab Baths** or **Hammam emerged**, with the latter being the

maximum exponent of the merger of art and Al-Andalus customs. Ablution and personal hygiene formed an essential part of Muslim life, since, apart from being a **basic principle of prayer**, they also carried out an important **social function** as meeting and leisure spaces. They were usually located near the mosques and they operated all day long with different times for men and women.

There are magnificent remains of Hamman in Andalusia, which can now

be visited, such as **the Arab Baths of Santa María** and the **Arab Baths of the Califal Alcázar** (both in Cordoba), those in (Malaga) and the **Arab Baths of the Villardompardo Palace** (Jaen) dating back to the 11th century, the restoration of which earned the Europa Nostra Restoration award in 1984. Of particular note in the province of Granada, are the luxurious **Royal Arab Baths of the Palace of Comares**, located inside the Alhambra in Granada or the Bañuelo Baths, also in the capital, together with the **Baza or Marzuela Baths**.



Averroes (1126-1198)

A jurist, philosopher and doctor, born in Cordoba, he was considered one of the most influential intellectuals of the entire Middle Ages. Apart from the Commentaries on Aristotle's works, his great contribution to universal culture was the book Kulliyat, the general principles of Medicine, in which he studied all the known subjects, particularly focusing on the Anatomy.



Flavours and traditions

The Al-Andalus past comes alive and is present in **traditional Andalusian cuisine**, which **seduces**, not only through its flavours and aromas, but also through its chromatic and precise presentation of some medieval dishes that have now been given new contemporary touch. We have the Muslims to thank for the **use of fruit and vegetables**, and the use of **dry fruit and nuts** in stews, meat dishes and

vegetables, mixtures of sweet and sour flavours and a **very personal style of confectionery** adopted by the Christians to a large extent.

This cuisine is also very present in most **Al-Andalus-themed festivals** held throughout Andalusia, in order to introduce this cultural legacy to visitors. These are usually held during the summer season and the common denominator is the use of **lighting with**

thousands of candles, bazaars with old-style Moorish artisan dresses, dance activities, concerts, parades and Arab sweet tasting, among many other activities. An example of this is the **Luna Mora Festival** in Guaro (Malaga), the **Muslim-Christian Workshops** in Zalamea la Real (Huelva), the **“Carratraca, Al-Andalus enchantment”** in Carratraca (Malaga), the Al-Andalus Arab Festival in Salares (Malaga) or the **Abén Humeya Moorish Games** held in Purchena

(Almeria), declared a Festival of Tourism Interest in Andalusia.

Some artisan activities inherited from the Muslims are still carried out today as they were in the past in cities such as **Granada**, where one can stroll through the **Alcaicería**, and old Arab silk market, admiring the **ceramic** items in its stores and others carried out using the **intarsia or wood incrustation** techniques. In Cordoba, the quality of its **leather industry** is recognised nationally and internationally, in particular, the *guadameci* and the *cordoban* artistic leatherwork techniques, caliphal ceramics and silversmithing using the **filigree** technique.

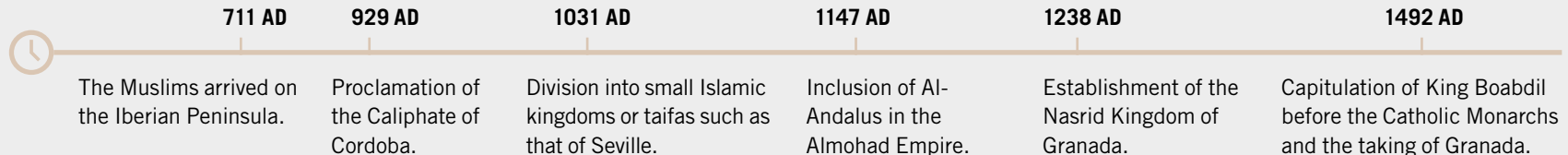

Did you know...

The phrase, “*You weep like a woman for what you could not defend as a man*” allegedly quoted by the sultana Aisha criticising her son Boabdil, when he handed over the keys of Granada to the Catholic Monarchs, is not true. There is evidence to prove that it was first written, three centuries later, by father Echevarría, in a work entitled *Los paseos de Granada*, with which he intended to paint an unfavourable picture of the Al-Andalus king.

'Andalusia, your Roots' offers a whole host of activities from those focused on discovering the cultural and monumental heritage of our ancestors, visiting artistic treasures dating back to the Al-Andalus period, to others focused more on leisure activities and relaxation, including Arab baths with relaxing massages, cookery workshops and Arab tea-tasting activities. All of this in quality establishments with special areas for prayer and restaurants offering halal cuisine. 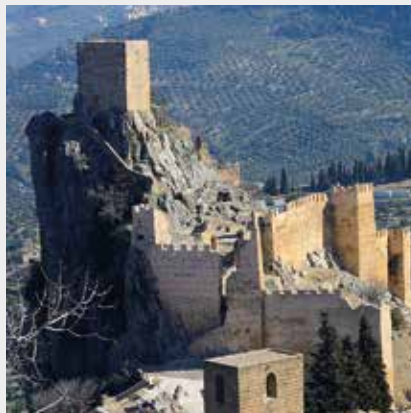

Cástulo: an example of the defensive construction of al-Ándalus

If for any reason the the province of Jaen stood out during the al-Ándalus period, it was because it established the border with the Christian kingdoms for several centuries. That is why it is one of the regions with the highest number of castles worldwide.



Near the city of Linares, the Hisn Gastulona (Cástulo), had a walled enclosure to protect it from the rebellious revolts of the Caliphs period, but it was with the Almohads, in the 17th-18th century, when it played a fundamental role and became one of the strategic points to try to defend the borders. As a result, a new fortification

was built with rammed earth or 'tabiyya'.

During the tour, we will see how the castle is still a benchmark in the countryside more than eight centuries later. It controls the area around it and has a direct vision of the other surrounding fortifications.

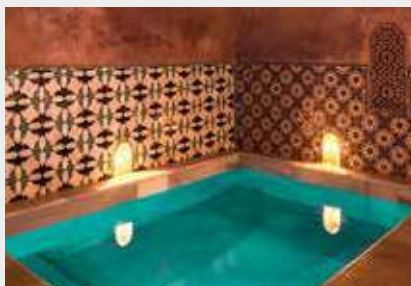

Madinat Al-Zahra, guided tour



The Madinat Al-Zahra, a palatine city commissioned by Abd Al-Rahman III in the first half of the 10th, is a faithful reflection of the splendour that surrounded the city of Cordoba after its proclamation as a Caliphate.

Although to date it has only been possible to excavate about a tenth of the palatine city, this is where the noble part of the city was concentrated. It was built in the foothills of the Sierra Morena, near Cordoba and from the upper part you look out over the rest of the city and the surrounding countryside. It is divided into three terraces, the top two are walled and corresponded to the living quarters of the Caliph, dignitaries, government officials and to military buildings. The

lower area which is still to be excavated was the city: the houses of the people, as well as the royal craft workshop, the mint and a prison.

Our visit takes us down from the Caliph's residence, through the guardroom, the house of Yafar, the servants quarters, the Salón Rico, the basilica, a porticoed building, the Parade Ground and the Aljama mosque.

The Walled Area de Marchena has a length of 2,500 metres and 3 large spaces: The old Madina, the Palace and the Finca de El Parque.

Of the Almohad period (12th century), the Arco de la Rosa (old Seville Gate) is worth mentioning, a significant masonry monument remodelled in 1430. The Morón Gate, a double gate which connected with the medina and currently houses the tourist office and the Expo Lorenzo Coullaut Valera. The Tiro de Santa María gate, which linked the palace with the medina. Ronda

of Alcazaba, spacious grounds of 2.3 hectares that are completely walled. It is a secondary gate. The Carmona Gate, one of most enigmatic of the site with a polygonal tower. It is known as Torre del Oro for its geometric resemblance to the tower of Seville. The Portillo Arch, gate located at the foot of the palace, gave access to the park and gardens of palace.

Visit to the Caliphate Silverwork workshop, where we will ourselves produce filigree using the traditional methods of 10th-century artisans: the originality and beauty of 10th-century jewellery.

Among the Al Andalus techniques that have comprised the tradition of Cordoba to date, we must highlight filigree. This technique comprises creating jewellery pieces by crimping threads of fine silver. You can contemplate at our shop-workshop the production of these pieces in real time, and will receive a detailed explanation of the traditional work methods of the Caliphal period, which we have recovered in our workshop. At our workshop-shops, you can find a unique exhibition of 10th-century



Caliphate Silverwork. Pieces made of silver of 925 mls, covered with white gold and combined with glazing for metals. A production method very similar to tile-making, which tricks the eyes, giving the sensation that precious stones are being seen, when, in fact, these are stained-glass windows that reveal unique nuances with the sun and light passing through.

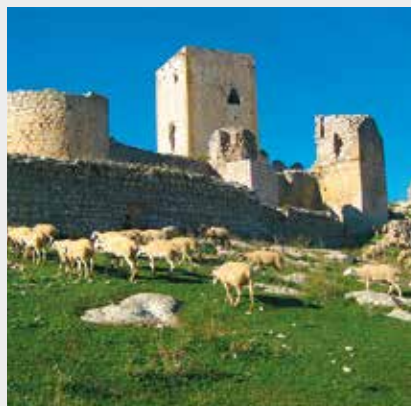

The Castles Route invites us to explore and discover all the stories, battles and border conflicts that took place in these lands.

Three villages and three castles: The Peña Castle was built in the late 9th century, during the uprising of Omar Ibn Hafsun. It was part of his kingdoms until the Omeyas of Cordoba put an end to the rebellion with the conquest of Bobastro. As of the 13th century, after the conquest of the Guadalquivir Valley by Castilian troops, the Castle of Ardales will regain importance, as the area became the border between Castile and the Nasrid kingdom of Granada. The Christian incursions to conquer it were frequent and the great interest of the Nasrid to maintain their control over the fortress which changed ownership on several occasions.



The Estrella Castle, of Teba, also conserves Muslim and Castilian areas, and the Hisn Cannit Castle, of Cañete la Real, is also part of the route.

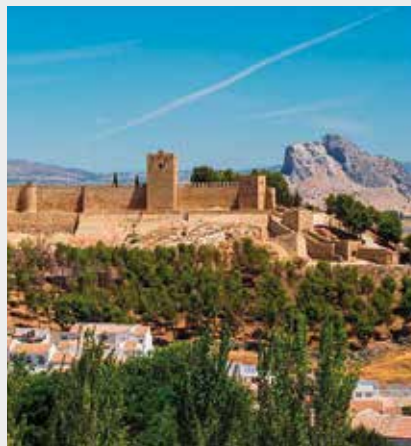
